The large conglomerate Martin Marietta, a billion dollar astronautics group, already deployed this product in one of its vehicle fleets and was able to save a very impressive amount of diesel within one year. Then there's the EPS sensor; it reduces the emissions of a car. This EPS sensor is under license from the University of Florida. And in this regard it's very, very exciting that the University of Florida is so convinced of the success of this product that they invested 4 million US dollar on their own to build the production plant for it. Therefore, EPS – Emission & Power Solutions – looks very interesting. In this year, they're still in the red, but already for next year, they're expecting profits. And in the near future – so I've heard – several Green Energy Funds – green funds – are looking to include this stock in their portfolios. Take a look at this stock, it hasn't been listed at the Frankfurt Stock Exchange for a long time yet, but it is really very, very exciting.*
